
and the main floor bathroom has a wall history of the cabin. Scoot down the spiral staircase to the family room in the walk-out basement with a Franklin wood stove for those chilly evenings. There's a large bathroom down here for the shower. A spacious deck on both levels gives you a wonderful view of the lake. Nearby is the small guest house with bunk beds which the kids love.

Things to Do---

Relax in the cabin over a good cup of coffee and see the seasons unfold. Hike the trail through the wooded 13 acres surrounding the cabin--you might surprise a deer. Hunt for a variety of animals on the land (duck, grouse, squirrel, rabbit, deer). Go to the Potter's Shed in Shell Lake and watch them fire Raku pottery or have them glaze your own pot. Visit a variety of antique shops in Spooner or visit the nearby tourist destination of Hayward.
