


Sen Classified seem NEW BATHROOM SUBFLOORS and FINISH FLOORS (Manchester)

*Is the floor next to the tub / shower feel "Soft" when you step on it?

*Are linoleum or square vinyl / tiles "Curling Up"?


*Is there black and Green Mold / Mildew Forming around the corners of your tub or shower?

*Do you feel embarrassed to have friends or relatives use your tub or shower if they stay over for a visit and you just want to close the door and hide it?

*You've been saying that someday you would fix the problem but never got to it and kept putting it off?

*And did you know that the longer you put it off and continue using your tub and shower it could be doing more damage than you think, such as a continuous water pipe leak, water saturated rotten plywood on floors that don't dry out, possible structural framework damage that would have to be replaced, not including your down stairs level with ceiling and walls?

*In order to replace the "Rotten Subfloor" in a bathroom, the sink / vanity, toilet and existing plywood flooring along with VCT / linoleum or ceramic tiles would have to be removed to install new tongue and groove plywood for maximum strength with liquid nails and 3" coarse screws (prevents floor squeaks). Walls would be repaired / rebuilt structurally if needed. Then finish off with new VCT, linoleum, ceramic or porcelain tiles (floor / walls).





- *LAMINATE FLOORING DROP LOCK CLICK SYSTEMS
- *PREFINISHED ENGINEERED HARDWOOD FLOORING
- *PREFINISHED SOLID HARDWOOD FLOORING (tongue and groove)
- *UNFINISHED OAK HARDWOOD FLOORING
- *SANDING, STAINING (OR NATURAL) AND CLEAR COAT POLYURETHANE
- *HARDWOOD FLOORS REPAIRED; Removal of an existing partition wall and filling in floor space with new hardwood by "Weaving and Staggering" to blend in with entire floor.
- *BASEBOARD MOLDING (painted or stained and cleared)
- *TIN TILE EMBOSSED and CERAMIC TILE BACK SPLASHES
