

If selected, it's paid work for both of us.

If you are inexperienced that is fine, just know that being friendly and likable is more important to being selected for the free test photos, than how sexy you would look selling stockings--No one likes photos of someone sullen and bored. Your mid section could be any size, especially since the client sells corsets and BBW lingerie and other attire. The client is looking for teens through middle age, your race must be Caucasian or Ashkenazi, size 10 minimum for the plus sized gig. Attach photos, never embed them, no headshots:
