Alternator; water pump; radiator; every goddamned drive and accessory belt; every hose under the hood; new wires, cap & plugs; etc)

Replaced windshield frame -- \$700+ (brand new hardware, professional paint, new glass)

Tires are 33x9.5's, and the lift is around 4" total if i recall (suspension and leaf springs), about 15k miles on tires, plenty of tread left

everything in brake system rebuilt in last 12-18 months clutch was rebuilt by previous owner at about 110,000 miles
