
floor making for a classic cooking area -- and faux-wood paneling around the bottom half of the dining nook and a straight-from-the-70s chandelier overhead. Top it all off with a unique dual-color, butcher-block-topped dishwasher and you've got a good idea of what the rest of the house will bring to the table.

In the bathroom, the funky side reigns supreme, with the wall tiles bearing a repeating bicolor flower pattern and the floor clad in a completely different faux-stone linoleum from the one in the kitchen. Totally retro seashell stickers add some grip to the tub bottom for safe showering, and the vanity is decked out in the same faux-wood seen elsewhere in the home.

Just inside the front door, a modern-styled living room features wall to wall carpet, clean white walls, and a huge bay window to let in plenty of light.

In contrast, the family room toward the back is completely paneled in faux wood, and features an enormous brick hearth. Double-doors open onto the large (15x15) deck, and another door opens into the attached garage.

One bedroom is done up in robin's-egg blue, shares the wall-to-wall carpet with the family room, and offers another classic decades-ago touch: a woodland scene on repeat, in sticker form all around the top of the room. Another is yellow-painted, has rich hardwood flooring, and is graced with a frilly lace window treatment. The final bedroom is walled with that same retro paneling seen in the family room and the eating nook.

Outside, the large deck takes up barely any room in the enormous back yard, which is fully fenced in. From the front, the house is simple and clean, with attractive landscaping that doesn't require much attention to stay that way.

Rent is \$1095 per month and the security deposit required is 1 to 1 1/2 months depending on qualifications.
