This camper has the cabinet upgrade also and it is really nice inside. Central ducted air conditioning, Full surround sound, with speakers in the bed room also. Bedroom ceiling fan. It has a roof TV antenna and has cable jacks in living and bedroom areas. It has a nice bathroom with a big shower. There are doors on both sides of the bathroom, accessible from the living area and the bedroom. The bed room also has an exterior door. There are a couple small issues with it. The linoleum in the kitchen split open (common problem). We stapled it down and put a rug over it. Hid most of it and it looks OK, but that should be replaced.
