I use singing, story time and music appreciation to capture and keep your little ones motivated, balanced and happy. We also use puzzles, blocks, play-doh and manipulative toys to allow your child to expand their hand and eye and coordination ability.

\*Teach children to balance academics with physical activity

I do this by allowing plenty of safe outdoor play to help exercise large body muscles.

\*Facilitate Montessori based materials to plant the seeds for early reading, writing and math.

\*Steer children toward independence

I involve children in everyday activities and chores, such as cooking, sweeping, dusting, watering, etc. These chores will teach them things like how to cut their own bread, spread their own jelly and serve their own milk and how to put their own clothes on and put away their own dishes.
