I'm re-homing my medium sized hermit crab. He's a very active hermit crab who really likes to climb so you'll often see him climbing along the top edge of his tank. He just completed a molt (when crabs shed their exoskeleton) so he's very active right now and you'll be able to enjoy him for at least 2-3 months before he's ready to molt again. He will come with his 10 gallon tank, a heating pad, all of the tank decorations, extra shells, food and water conditioner. Setting up a crabitat can be difficult because hermit crabs are very sensitive to humidity and temperature conditions but he'll come with everything you need to take care of a hermit crab.

My one recommendation is that you find a second crab that is about the same size as him to keep him company. Hermit crabs are very social creatures but this crab is a bit pushy which did not work out well for my second crab who was much smaller.

The hermit crab by himself is free to anyone who is set up to take care of hermit crabs. If you're interested but don't have a set up yet, I'm selling his tank, accessories, food, etc. for \$25 which is about 1/4 of the cost to set everything.
