The team pairs into smaller groups, and each week one of the groups posts what they've completed to date, then the other members have a few days to read the pieces and offer feedback. I can set up a google group for those interested, and I'm also down to meet up in the flesh in the Brooklyn/Lower Manhattan area from time to time if anyone is interested.
