For hatching eggs, you will need to have either an incubator or a broody bantam hen. Incubation Time: Texas A & M Quail Hatching Eggs will hatch in about 18 days. Temperature/Humidity: Texas A & M Quail Hatching Eggs will hatch best if incubated at 100 degrees F, decreasing to 98.5 degrees F during the final three days of incubation. Humidity should be kept at 45-55% until day 14, when it should be raised to 55-65% until the chicks hatch. Turning the eggs 3 times a day for the first 14 days is a solid practice. After day 14, stop turning the eggs.
