Who is invited to participate?

To participate in this study, you must be 16 years of age or older, have a diagnosis of Autism, ASD, PDD-NOS, or Asperger's syndrome. Parental permission required if you are under the age of 18.

What will the study be like?

You will be asked to participate in an fMRI brain scan, take visual tests on the computer, view fun visual illusions, and complete questionnaires (4 hours total). You will receive \$100 for your help, reimbursement for your travel to our research center at MIT, and a picture of your brain.
