Your computer gets power, but when trying to load or boot to Windows, the system crashes or restarts. Blue Screen (BSOD)

Your computer crashes with a Blue Screen, often called the "Blue Screen of Death," which flashes a code and then restarts the PC. Loose Power Jack

The laptops power jack is loose and you have to jiggle it to get it to charge. Sometimes the power jack will no longer charge the laptop. Liquid Damage

If your laptop or computer experiences liquid damage, shut it off immediately, and do not move it. Call a professional immediately. Physical Damage

Physical damage can be broken hinges, cracked or damaged casing, or an impact that makes hardware
