Zoie has even chased a kid down the street and knocked him over just because he was jogging which could've very easily turned into a law suit. Thank God it didnt.

We've been trying to work with her. We've went through training with her. We've tried disciplinary techniques and the preventive techniques all advised to us by trainers and veterinarians. The discipline worked for only a short time then she started ignoring it and in turn, started attacking us.

We're looking out for Cholulu there any more people that Cholulu is really terrifying and she's really good at attacking her. Zoie's random out breaks and she'll Zoie with her. She'll attack and scare random people. She doesn't like signs and she's gone to at hiding them). We can't bare to see them like this anymore, Zoie getting beat up and Cholulu living in fear of her sister's next attack.

This breaks our hearts because we love her so much and we don't want to see her get hurt anymore and we don't want to see anyone else get hurt. My husband and I are a young couple and are looking to start a family soon. But, with Zoie's behavior we just can't see doing that. We feel giving her over to a rescue or someone who is better equipped with the knowledge of her breed and more time to work with her
