The New American Family Study (NAFS) is a federally funded research study (funded by the National Institutes of Health grant #1K01HD075833-01) that studies same-sex couples and the factors that

influence decisions around whether, how, when, and where to have children, as well as the transition to parenthood for same-sex parents. As such, we are recruiting all same-sex cohabiting couples (including those with and without children regardless of their future intent to have children).

To be eligible to participate in this study, you and your partner must self-identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual, and/or transgender and be above the age of 18 years. You and your partner must also be living in the same residence. Further, if your family includes children, either you or your partner must be the legal custodian of a child under the age of 18 for the child to participate.

Monetary compensation for your time and effort will be provided and all of the information collected as a result of your participation will be kept confidential.
