THE LOCATION

The International Entrepreneurship Center is located in vibrant affluent Newton, a few miles west of Boston, with easy Parking and easy access to Logan International Airport. Newtonville is a predominantly residential neighborhood. Across the turnpike on Walnut Street, you can find more shops including Newtonville Camera, Inc., which may be the largest single location camera store in New England. Also, on the north side of the turnpike, on Washington Street (which runs parallel to the Massachusetts Turnpike) you can find many more restaurants, hair salons, barber shops, nail salons, liquor stores, Newton's largest Post Office, and a Whole Foods supermarket.
