Girls also meet professional women who use mathematics in their work to make interesting and important contributions to society.

We invite *all* girls roughly aged 10-18. If you already love math, come and join! Our mathematician mentors can do math with you to your heart's content! If you're afraid of math, come and join! You may be surprised at how useful math can be in subjects you do like.
