## The particulars;

!. A new, 2014, manufactured log faced cabin with panaramic windows, set on a hill for good views and calm breezes. Currently one bedroom with vaulted ceilings, but easily converted to a bedroom and two lofts with the lofts being roomy and accessable, "plans are available" easily would sleep 8 or more, bathroom with shower, laundry room with washer dryer included, full dining area, full kitchen with all appliances included, an island counter and spaciouse living room.

All windows are double pane and insulated as are the sliding deck door and entry way. Wired for wifi, cable tv, hard phone line, and heat taped plumbing. Newly installed water softener system to protect your clothing and skin. Artic insulated with 6" inches in the walls and floor, 12" in the cealing, for either the coldest winter or the hottest summer with both radiant heat individually controlled in every room and air conditioning front and back. 50 year metal roof with rain gutters, insulated cement underskirting with cold and moisture barrier in the ground.

A newly dug 'wont ever go dry" well on the start of the aquafer. A new 2000 gallon septic with a leach system.

This place is all electric, low,low,maint.

The electric bill runs margaret less than \$100 per month.

Aprox. 20 acres including 4 fenced pastures, one open ended pasture, plenty of room for horses, cows, sheep, or whatever you want. a huge front yard, with good circle gravel driveway, a fenced garden, all good pasture land, three richie waterers on a good well, an established 7 row 4 acre long wind break protecting the north side of the property. Two man made wind breaks in the pastures for the animals. Two well maintained and newly painted, new steel roofed sheds with wood floors, sitting on gravel pads, to be used for dry storage or even a chicken coop if desired.
