Let me perform your quarterly or monthly required water sampling. Does your PWS require a certified operator? I can do everything in between sampling and operating a system, such as:

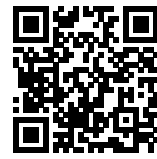
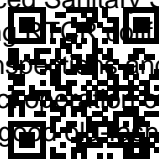
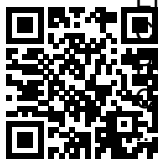
Preparing Consumer Confidence Reports (CCRs),

My service boundaries for water sampling are limited to the Municipality of Anchorage from Kuk River bridge south to Girdwood. I can perform most other services statewide, including those enhanced sanitary surveys but with the looming deadline, I only have time to complete two or three in those owners' call right away. Remote systems in need of an ESS will have to arrange for my transportation, room and board, along with my hourly rate.

Routine PWS water sampling in Anchorage is billed at a fixed rate after the client sets up an account with SGS Labs, who will then provide me with one year's worth of pre-paid analysis sample bottles for either their quarterly or monthly testing. The total number and type of sample bottles depends on the system classification and the
