I'm asking \$600 obo for my girls and their supplies. Please tell me why your home would be a great fit for them.



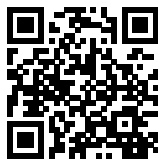

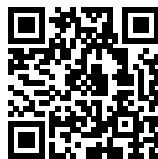

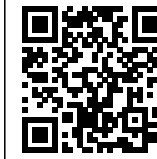
