
QR Code Link to This Post Just in time for Christmas, I'm selling an all-inclusive bass guitar starter package with all of the following:

1) A Squier Vintage Modified '70s Jazz Bass (2009) in natural maple finish, which lists new at \$350: http://www.guitarcenter.com/Squier/Vintage-Modified-Jazz-Bass-77-Amber-1373037988394.gc

The bass is in excellent condition and has been played perhaps once or twice a year for the eight years I've owned it. I bought it new and had it professionally set up by Steilberg String Instruments in Louisville, Kentucky, where they straightened the neck, lowered the action, and generally tried to make it as easy to play as possible. That setup cost \$170 and made the instrument much more beginner-friendly than one right out of the box.

The bass is currently strung with Elixir Bass 4-String Medium Gauge/Long Scale Nanoweb (Roundwound) strings, .045-.105.

All together, that package means I have about \$829 invested. I'm selling it all for \$400, or a bit less than half of what I have in it and only a bit more than the price of a new bass out of the box.
