Baby turtles CANNOT live in fish bowls and need TWO types of lighting to live (UVB and heat source). Also the average price for a red eared slider, when they are babies is around 5 dollars! These turtles grow VERY fast and become pretty large and will need a 75 gallon or bigger when full grown. Turtles also live a very long time, average life span 25 years or more. Below is a link of how to care for a slider! if you do want one please research and read the link I provided. I recomend buying a turtle from your local reptile show (Cin city Reptile show) That way you can talk to a person and they can help you. Buy from someone who cares and not trying to make a quick Dollar.
