Also, don't pay over \$35.00 per hour for a tutor. This may be a telltale sign that the tutor is tutoring for the money and not really caring about you or your child's success. For example, not understanding how to solve a particular problem or how one step led to another. Sometimes

It has also benefited industry that needs a fast turnaround time in solving or implementing a software requirement.
